Medicaid Waivers

Virginia Medicaid provides two types of waivers:

1. Developmental Disability (DD) Waiver

Virginia has three waivers for individuals with a developmental disability:

- Building Independence (for individuals 18 and older)
- Family & Individual Support
- Community Living

Respite Services

HSCSN enrollees under the age of 21 may receive Respite Services.

- Up to 480 hours of Respite Services each calendar year (January 1 to December 31)
- Unused hours cannot be transferred from year to year
- Only a Personal Care Aide from a Home Care Agency in the HSCSN network can offer Respite Services

To request Respite services:

- 1. Obtain the form from your HSCSN Care Manager or download it from the <u>HSCSN</u> <u>website</u>
- 2. Fax the form to 202-407-8955 or email it to RespiteRequests@hschealth.org
- 3. Expect a decision within five (5) business days
